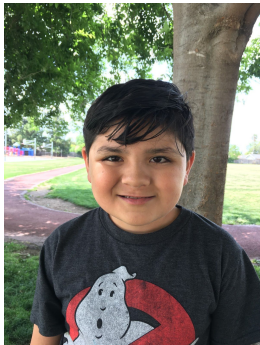
A Year's End

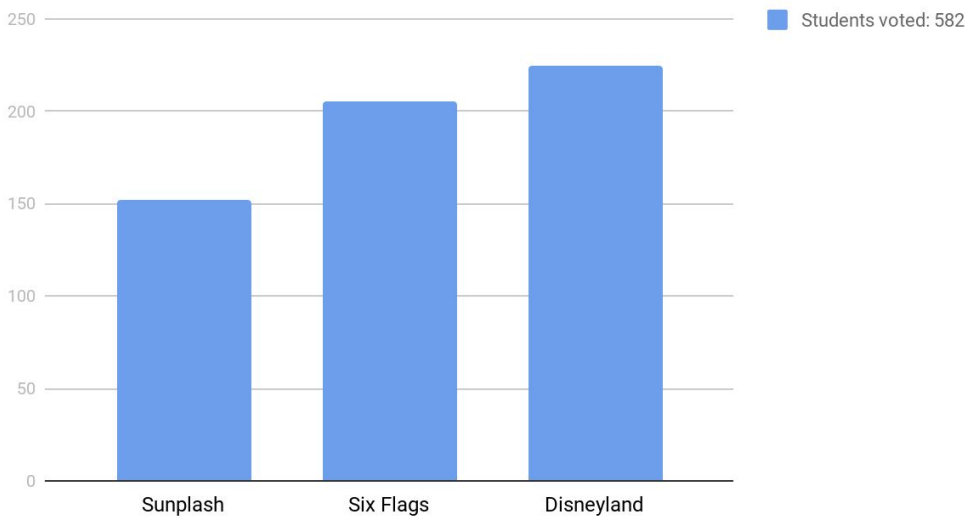
Jog-a-thon!
